## **OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

## FOR THE 2024 GREAT ASHUELOT RIVER DUCK RACE

- 1. Winning yellow ducks and one purple duck will be randomly drawn from eligible entries at approximately NOON on SATURDAY, June 29, 2024.
- 2. Each duck will be assigned a number by the Race Officials and the entire listing of duck assignments shall be available on written request from the Race Officials or at the day of the event location. You must present your name, and telephone number (as they appear on your sponsorship registration form) in order to check your duck number assignments.
- 3. No duplicate prizes shall be awarded to any individual duck number.
- 4. Mailed in entry forms must be completed, sent to PO Box 62, Keene, NH 03431, or delivered to Duck Central (any Savings Bank of Walpole location). Ducks can also be purchased online at keenelions.com. Mailed and online entries and payment must be received by 3:00 PM, JUNE 28, 2024 in order to be eligible to win a prize.
- 5. Winners will be announced at Keene Recreation Center at approximately NOON on the day of the Race.
- 6. No cash equivalent prizes will be provided in lieu of designated prizes.
- By entering, entrants release The Keene Lions Foundation, Inc./Keene Lions Club their members, agents, employees, event sponsors and other related entities from any liability with respect to prizes.
